Workshop: Legal Issues in Language Resources and Infrastructures May 27, 2014 (14:00-18:00)

Workshop Aims:

To discuss and update the community regarding emerging legal issues in language technologies, recent changes to applicable laws, and new legal resources for language scientists that have been developed over the past two years. The legal challenges facing language infrastructures, including the use of intellectual property across multiple jurisdictions, are a key part of this dialogue.

Workshop Topics:

- issues in copyright and other intellectual property laws
- legal issues affecting language resources and infrastructures
- current and upcoming changes to applicable laws (i.e. re: open access, text and data mining, orphan works, and the upcoming copyright law revision in the EU)
- challenges and lessons learned in sharing resources across institutes, projects, and researchers, including from research infrastructures

Programme:

The Legal Workshop will include invited talks, oral presentations, and a panel discussion.
